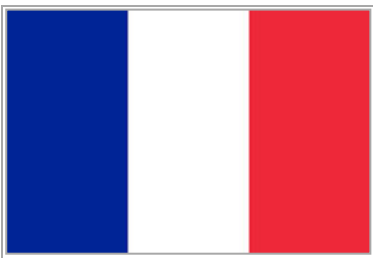


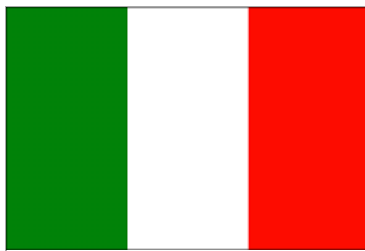
PARTICIPATING COUNTRIES

FORMULA AND DRAW

PRELIMINARY ROUND

One group of 7 (seven) teams. A, B, C, D, E, F, G.

Each team play against the others: 6 (six) matches for team.

The combination of the letters to the participating countries will take place through a draw that will take place during the Technical Meeting.

PLACEMENT MATCHES

The Team ranked first is directly qualified to the semifinals and will challenge the winner between the 4th and 5th.

Team ranked 2nd will play against team ranked 7th

Team ranked 3rd will play against team ranked 6th

Team ranked 4th will play against team ranked 5th

The winners of these matches will qualify for the semifinals.

The losers will play against each other to establish a ranking of the 5th, 6th and 7th place.

TECHNICAL RULES OF COMPETITION

Duration of the games:

45 minutes (3 x 15 minutes). 3 timeouts per team per game

Counting of points:

- In each half, 1 more point will be available for the winner.
- In case of draw, the point will be divided by both teams (0,5 + 0,5).

Final result:

Win: 2 points
Draw: 1 point
Defeat: 0 point

The final scoring of each match should add up to 5 points

Duration of the final game:

- 1 hour (3 x 20 minutes). 3 timeouts per team per game.
- In case of draw, 5 penalty shots will follow immediately without extra time.
- One side change.
- Draw for the court side and throw-off for the possession of the ball once the teams enter the hall.
- At the end of the second period, there will be a draw for the throw off of the third period.

Please bring with you the Passport, the Delegation List of the Players and the Officials, for confirmation by the M.H.C. Delegate. Only four Officials are allowed to be registered in the match report. Please remember that each player must have the same number during all the competition.

2) Colours of dresses

Please bring with you your official equipment because the Colours sheet of the Competition will be filled in during the Technical Meeting.

3) Obligation of participating team

The organizational matters will be communicated during the meeting.

4) National Anthem

The National Anthems will be verified during the meeting.

5) Closing Ceremony

All Teams must use the Officials Sport Uniform.



PARTICIPATION IN THE CHAMPIONSHIPS OF NON-MEDITERRANEAN COUNTRIES
